COVID-19 – PLANNING DOCUMENT

Updated: April 26, 2022

THE GUIDELINES BELOW WERE DEVELOPED BASED ON WHAT IS CURRENTLY KNOWN ABOUT THE TRANSMISSION AND SEVERITY OF COVID-19 AND COVID-19 VARIANTS AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

The following i	rules apply to all NYSBC staff:
Vaccination	All staff members are required to be fully vaccinated. You will be considered fully vaccinated 7 days after receiving a booster shot. A copy of your proof of vaccination (e.g., CDC card, NYS Excelsior Pass) should be sent to Arjun Koshal.
Masks	Masks are strongly recommended to be worn in the Center unless you are alone in your lab or office.
COVID-19 Symptoms	Even if you have been vaccinated, DO NOT come to the Center if you have any of the following symptoms: Cough Repeated shaking with chills Fever Chills New loss of taste or smell Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Muscle pain Headache Sore throat
Protocol for Exposure to COVID-19	If you have received your booster shot and are asymptomatic, you may return to the Center after close contact ² with someone who had COVID-19. However, you must wear a KN95 or N95 mask for 10 days after your close contact and we recommend that you get tested 5 to 7 days after the close contact with a rapid antigen test, even if you do not have symptoms. Notify your supervisor and Arjun Koshal of any close contact with someone who had COVID-19.

¹ Reasonable accommodations will be made for staff who refuse vaccination due to pregnancy, disability or sincerely held religious belief or practice.

² "Close contact" occurs when an individual was within 6 feet of someone for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.

Protocol for COVID-19 Symptoms and/or Positive Test	 If you think or know you have COVID-19, and you have symptoms, you can only return to the Center after: 10 days since symptoms first appeared, 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications, and other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving.³
	If you test positive and have no symptoms, you can return to the Center after 10 days have passed since you had a positive test (based on the date you were tested). If you develop symptoms after testing positive, your 10-day isolation period will start over. Notify your supervisor and Arjun Koshal have COVID-19 symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19.
Transportation	If you travel by public transportation, taxi or car service, wear a KN95 or N95 mask and, to the extent possible, stay at least six feet from other people.
Travel	 All international travelers must: Monitor symptoms for 14 days after arriving in New York; and Immediately self-isolate if any symptoms develop and contact the local public health authority or your healthcare provider to determine if you should get tested.

The following rules apply to affiliates, visitors, and contractors:		
Vaccination	Affiliates, visitors, and contractors who do not show proof of vaccination must:	
	 take a rapid antigen test upon entering the facility (maximum of one test per week if visiting for more than one day), and wear a KN95 or N95 mask at all times while onsite. 	
COVID-19 Symptoms	Even if affiliates, visitors or contractors have been vaccinated, they are not permitted to come to the Center if they have any COVID-19 symptoms (described above).

³ Loss of taste and smell may persist for weeks or months after recovery and need not delay the end of isolation.
