COVID-19 – PLANNING DOCUMENT

<u>Updated: May 9, 2022</u>

THE GUIDELINES BELOW WERE DEVELOPED BASED ON WHAT IS CURRENTLY KNOWN ABOUT THE TRANSMISSION AND SEVERITY OF COVID-19 AND COVID-19 VARIANTS AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

The following	The following rules apply to all NYSBC staff:	
Vaccination	All staff members are required to be fully vaccinated. You will be considered fully vaccinated 7 days after receiving a booster shot. A copy of your proof of vaccination (e.g., CDC card, NYS Excelsior Pass) should be sent to Arjun Koshal.	
Masks	Masks are strongly recommended to be worn in the Center unless you are alone in your lab or office.	
COVID-19 Symptoms	 Even if you have been vaccinated, DO NOT come to the Center if you have any of the following symptoms: Cough Repeated shaking with chills Fever Chills New loss of taste or smell Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Muscle pain Headache Sore throat 	
Protocol for Exposure to COVID-19	If you have received your booster shot and are asymptomatic, you may return to the Center after being exposed to someone who had COVID-19. However, you must wear a KN95 or N95 mask for 10 days after your exposure and we recommend that you get tested with a rapid antigen test 5 to 7 days after the exposure, even if you do not have symptoms. Notify your supervisor and Arjun Koshal of any close contact with someone who had COVID-19.

¹ Reasonable accommodations will be made for staff who refuse vaccination due to pregnancy, disability or sincerely held religious belief or practice.

Protocol for COVID-19 Symptoms and/or Positive Test	All individuals who test positive for COVID-19 can return onsite after 5 days if (i) they are asymptomatic or their symptoms are resolving (without fever for 24 hours), and (ii) they test negative twice using a rapid antigen test (or once with a PCR test) within 24 hours of their proposed return onsite. Day 0 is considered the first day of symptom onset and/or the day of a positive test result. You must wear a KN95 or N95 mask while around others for an additional 5 days. Individuals who are moderately-severely immunocompromised should return onsite after 10 days. Notify your supervisor and Arjun Koshal if you have COVID-19 symptoms or tested positive for COVID-19.
Transportation	If you travel by public transportation, taxi or car service, wear a KN95 or N95 mask and, to the extent possible, stay at least six feet from other people.

The following rules apply to affiliates, visitors, and contractors:		
Vaccination	Affiliates, visitors, and contractors who do not show proof of vaccination must:	
	 take a rapid antigen test upon entering the facility (maximum of one test per week if visiting for more than one day), and wear a KN95 or N95 mask at all times while onsite. 	
COVID-19 Symptoms	Even if affiliates, visitors or contractors have been vaccinated, they are not permitted to come to the Center if they have any COVID-19 symptoms (described above).
