

COVID-19 – PLANNING DOCUMENT

THE GUIDELINES BELOW WERE DEVELOPED BASED ON WHAT IS CURRENTLY KNOWN ABOUT THE TRANSMISSION AND SEVERITY OF COVID-19 AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.	
Vaccination	All staff members are required to be fully vaccinated. ¹ A copy of your proof of vaccination should be sent to Arjun Koshal.
COVID-19 Symptoms	Even if you have been vaccinated, DO NOT come to the Center if you have any of the following symptoms:• Cough• Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing• Repeated shaking with chills• Muscle pain• Fever• Headache• Chills• Sore throat• New loss of taste or smell• Sore throat
Protocol for Exposure to COVID-19	You may return to the Center after being exposed to someone with COVID-19. However, you must wear a KN95 or N95 mask for 10 days after your exposure and we recommend that you test 5 to 7 days after the exposure, even if you do not have symptoms.
Protocol for COVID-19 Symptoms and/or Positive Test	You may return onsite 5 days after testing positive if (i) you are asymptomatic or your symptoms are resolving (without fever for 24 hours), and (ii) you test negative <u>twice</u> within 24 hours of your proposed return. Day 0 is the first day of symptom onset and/or the day of a positive test result. You must wear a KN95 or N95 mask while around others for an additional 5 days.

¹ Reasonable accommodations will be made for staff who refuse vaccination due to pregnancy, disability or sincerely held religious belief or practice.
