

## COVID-19 – PLANNING DOCUMENT

Updated: March 16, 2023

THE GUIDELINES BELOW WERE DEVELOPED BASED ON WHAT IS CURRENTLY KNOWN ABOUT THE TRANSMISSION AND SEVERITY OF COVID-19 AND ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.	
<b>Vaccination</b>	All staff members are required to be fully vaccinated. <sup>1</sup> A copy of your proof of vaccination should be sent to Arjun Koshal.
<b>COVID-19 Symptoms</b>	Even if you have been vaccinated, DO NOT come to the Center if you have any of the following symptoms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cough</li> <li>• Repeated shaking with chills</li> <li>• Fever</li> <li>• Chills</li> <li>• New loss of taste or smell</li> <li>• Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing</li> <li>• Muscle pain</li> <li>• Headache</li> <li>• Sore throat</li> </ul>
<b>Protocol for Exposure to COVID-19</b>	You may return to the Center after being exposed to someone with COVID-19. However, you must wear a KN95 or N95 mask for 10 days after your exposure and we recommend that you test 5 to 7 days after the exposure, even if you do not have symptoms.
<b>Protocol for COVID-19 Symptoms and/or Positive Test</b>	You may return onsite 5 days after testing positive if (i) you are asymptomatic or your symptoms are resolving (without fever for 24 hours), and (ii) you test negative <u>twice</u> within 24 hours of your proposed return. Day 0 is the first day of symptom onset and/or the day of a positive test result.  You must wear a KN95 or N95 mask while around others for an additional 5 days.

<sup>1</sup> Reasonable accommodations will be made for staff who refuse vaccination due to pregnancy, disability or sincerely held religious belief or practice.
